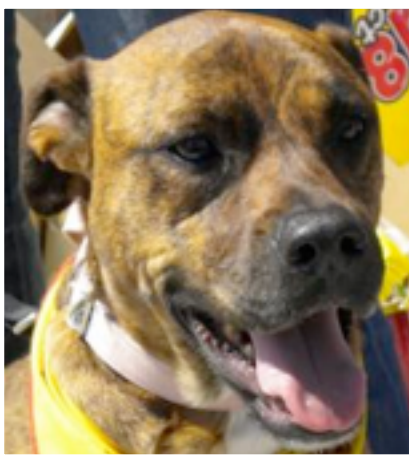
# Featured Adoptable Pets

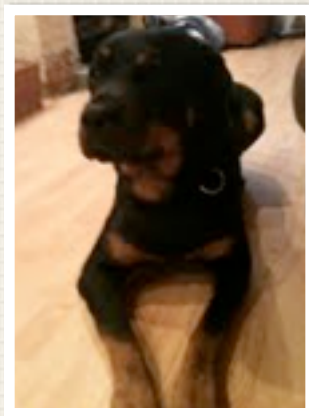

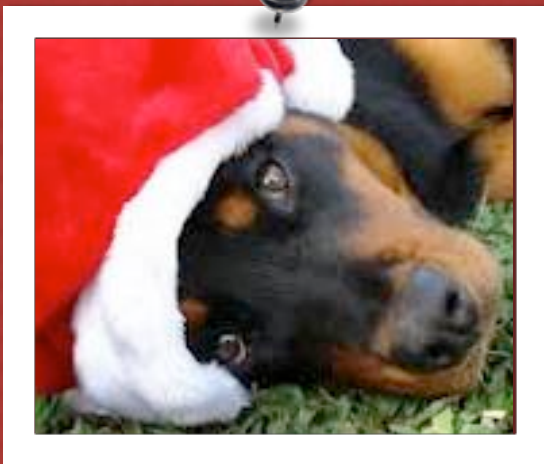
